Even otherwise the RTI was raised on Ministry of Urban Development . In my opinion the the Information should have been taken from Ministry of Urban Development or its PIO or email_id of single authority capable to give nodal officer's name,etc should have been furnished, the PDF attached with RTI seems to have been not perused.</p> <p>Point No. 3 & 4: Just because Swachha Bharat Mission Gramin has not defined the term Garbage Dump does not mean that not a single Central Govt Agency dealing with Swachhata Moud App has not done it or accepted it. So the CPIO should have either tried to get it or forwarded the RTI to the Right Department/ Authority/CPIO. It may please be noted that lack of definition gives courage to the Officers in The Local Govt to reject the Complaints lodged via the Swachhata App . In fact once the definition is given the decision making will be simple and there will be very little scope for disputes.</p> <p>Point No. 5 : Ok</p> <p>Point No. 6: After few rounds in orbit and hiccups, the Point was answered by same CPIO. But since the crux of matter (i.e. exactly what is covered under category of "Garbage Dump") is left unanswered (refer Point 3 and 4 above) the reply is not acceptable .</p>
