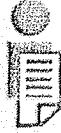

Please note the following important information.

- Requested information shall either be released on payment of prescribed fee or rejected for any of the reasons specified under section 8 and 9 of the RTI Act, 2005 by the concerned Public Information Officer(s) as expeditiously as possible, and in any case within *thirty days/ *within forty eight hours if concerns to the life and liberty of a person, from this receipt. A period of five days shall be added in computing the period for response if the request is given to the Assistant Public Information Officer. Further a period of ten days shall be added in the response time in case any third party shall be required to be given opportunity to make representation.
- In case the applicant does not receive a decision within the maximum time period as stated in Para 1 above or he/she feel aggrieved with the decision of the Public Information Officer(s) of Delhi Jal Board, he/she may directly prefer an appeal under section 19 of the RTI Act to the concerned First Appellate Authority under RTI Act, as per list given overleaf along with a copy of the RTI application and this acknowledgement and reply (if any) of the Public Information Officer(s) of Delhi Jal Board.
- In case the requested information is related to more than one Public Authorities or with the Public Authority situated outside Delhi, the applicant will himself have to make separate RTI request to such other Public Authority under section 6(1) and 6(3) of the RTI Act as clarified by DoPT's OM No.10/2/2008-IR dated 12.06.2008.
- While giving the request under section 7(1) of the RTI Act, the applicant will have to accompany concrete evidences to justify as to how receipt or non receipt of requested information within 48 hours will cause immediate threat to his/her life and liberty.
