4 After hearing, both the parties, we have to consider the case of the Petitioner referring to the equivalence, which is relevant for future courses of study in Maharashtra, as the Petitioner has placed and relied upon a certificate issued by Delhi Board of Senior Secondary Education. However, in view of the fact that the examination is scheduled in May, by keeping all points open, we are inclined to direct the concerned Respondents to permit the Petitioner to appear in forthcoming BAMS examination. Respondent No.1 to complete the formalities in this respect.


5 However, it is subject to further orders of this Court. There is no question of claiming any equity, if adverse order is passed against the Petitioner.

6 In the meantime, Respondent No.2 College is also directed to forward the examination form of the Petitioner to Respondent No.1.
