Scheme of Examination: –

Part - I

Written Test (MCQ based): Total 150 Marks (1 mark each MCQ)

a) MCQ Syllabus: –

- General Knowledge and current affairs – 40 marks
- English Language – 40 marks
- General Arithmetic – 25 marks
- Logical & Analytical Reasoning – 25 marks
- Computer Knowledge/Application – 20 marks

b) Essay writing : 50 Marks (25 X 2)

Part - II Typing Test (Qualifying Nature) : 30 wpm and one problem solving in MS Excel application.

Part - III Interview : 20 Marks

N.B: –

- The qualifying marks of each examination will be 50% for General/OBC Category and 45% for SC/ST/PWD candidate (s). There is 0.20 negative marking for each wrong answer for Part- I (a).
- Part – II examination shall only be taken from those candidate who will pass the Part – I examination.
- Part – III examination shall only be taken from those candidates who will pass the Part – II examination.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR CANDIDATES

1. Candidate has to bring any one of the following valid Photo ID card along with the admit card for verification at the examination centre such as Voter ID Card, PAN Card, Adhaar Card, Driving License etc.
2. The candidate should report at the examination centre 30 minutes before the commencement of examination.
3. Candidate without Admit Card shall not be allowed in the examination under any circumstances by the Centre Superintendent/Supervisor.
4. Candidate shall not be allowed to leave the Examination Room/Hall before the conclusion of the examination and without handing over the Answer Sheet and Question paper to the invigilator concerned.
5. Candidate should check and ensure that the Test Booklet contains as number of pages as written on the top of the cover page.
6. Candidate should bring good quality blue / black ball point pens for the examination. USE of pencil is strictly prohibited.
- 7. There is 0.20 negative marking for each wrong answer for Part- I (a) paper.**
8. Candidate should use blue / black ball point pen only to write particulars on the cover page of Test Booklet, Answer Sheet and for darkening the circles of responses.
9. Calculators, Log Tables, Calculating devices, communication devices like mobile phone, pager or any electronic gadgets etc. and textual material is strictly prohibited in the examination centre.
10. If any candidate is in possession of any electronic gadgets / cellular phone / mobile phone / pager or textual material during the examination , the same shall be forfeited and his / her candidature will be cancelled immediately.
11. The Admit Card is issued provisionally to the candidate as per the information provided by him/her. The final eligibility of the candidate has not been verified from the original documents by NBE.
12. Qualifying the Written Test would not confer a right on any person for the aforesaid recruitment as it is only one of the processes of recruitment for the post of Jr. Assistant.
13. The candidate must note that if ineligibility is detected at any stage, the candidature will be cancelled.
14. Note: The candidate has to get his passport size photograph and signature on the admit card. Candidate without photograph and signature on the admit card will not be permitted in the examination centre.
15. In case it is detected at any stage of recruitment that a candidate does not fulfill the eligibility norms and / or that he / she has furnished any incorrect / false information or has suppressed any material fact(s), his / her candidature will stand cancelled. If any of these shortcomings is/are detected even after appointment, his / her services are liable to be terminated.
16. Decisions of NBE in all matters regarding eligibility, conduct of written examination, other tests and selection would be Final and binding on all candidates. No representation or correspondence will be entertained by the NBE in this regard.
