Queries No.	Replies
1	As the subject matter pertains to Ministry of Electronics & IT, it is transferred to CPIO/Dy. Director (e-Gov), Ministry of Electronics & Information Technology, ND-03 under Section 6(3) of the RTI act to provide the information available with them and necessary action in this regards.
2	As the subject matter pertains to Ministry of Railways, it is transferred to CPIO, Railway Board, Ministry of Railways, ND-01 under Section 6(3) of the RTI act to provide the information available with them and necessary action in this regards.
3, 4 & 5	With reference to your queries it is stated that the certificates related to vehicle shall always be carried in the vehicle and produced on demand by the officers referred to in sub-rule (1)&(2) of rule 116 & rule 139 of Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 (CMVRs) and sections 130 of MV Act. Provisions regarding production of documents are also contained in rule 38 of The Motor vehicles (driving) Regulations, 2017 (G.S.R.634(E), dtd.23.06.2017 - available on this Ministry's official website). However, State Govt.s and UTs are being sensitized w.r.t. use of digilocker.

Implementation of provisions of Central Motor Vehicles Rule, 1989 (CMVRs) and Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 comes under the purview of State Transport Departments/UTs. You may, therefore, write to the notified Public Authority in the State / UT concerned for further requisite information.
