G.S.R. 1183(E)—Whereas, the draft rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989 were published, as required by sub-section (1) of Section 212 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), vide notification of the Government of India in the Ministry of Road Transport and Highways number G.S.R. 7441(E), dated the 15th July, 2016, in the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, Part II, Section (3), Sub-section (ii) inviting objections and suggestions from all persons likely to be affected thereby before the expiry of the period of thirty days from the date on which copies of the said notification containing the draft rules were made available to the public.

And whereas, copies of the said Gazette notification were made available to the public on the 28th July, 2016.

And whereas, no objections and suggestions were received from the public in respect of the said draft rules.

Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 119 of the Motor Vehicles Act, 1988 (59 of 1988), the Central Government hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989, namely:

- (1) These rules may be called the Central Motor Vehicles (Twenty-second Amendment) Rules, 2016.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- (3) They shall be published in the Official Gazette in the Central Motor Vehicles Rules, 1989.
- (4) In rule 9, in sub-rule (2), for the words, letters and figures "as specified in the Table in rule 9" the words and figures "as specified in the Table in rule 9" shall be substituted.



(c) in rule 14, in sub-rule (1), for clause (b), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:  
 "(b) appropriate fee as specified in rule 32, for the test, or the subsequent test, as the case may be, of competence to drive for each class and for issue of licence."  
 (iii) for rule 32, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

32. Fees.—The fees which shall be charged under the provisions of this Chapter shall be as specified in the table below.  
 Provided that the States may levy additional amounts to cover the cost of automation and technology adopted for conducting the testing or providing value added services
