2. Up to my knowledge NOC application form 18 says it's been issued for transfer/selling of vehicle to other state. But why I have to do this just for staying a week or a month at other state cities?
3. Chennai traffic police are saying every state got different Road transport and motor vehicle rules/act, is that TRUE? Central Road transport and motor vehicle rules/act are much more different from state rules? I HAD ENQUIRED BOTH (Chennai, tamilnadu and Pondicherry RTO) REGARDING THIS BUT NO FRUITFULL PROBLEM SOLVING ANSWER... HENCE THIS RTI....
4. TO BE PRECISE, I WANT TO KNOW WHEN AM NOT INTERESTED TO TRANSFER MY VEHILCE TO OTHER STATE, WHETHER I HAVE TO OBTAINING NOC FOR SHORT TERM STAY?
