4 As per circular by MCI in 2013 the students who are going abroad in same year dont have to apply for eligiblity certificate and in guidelines to get admission in abroad its mentioned that student has to pass 12th science and nowhere its mentioned that student has to secure 50% marks combinely in Physics, Chemistry and Biology so students who went abroad for MBBS and had less than 50% then whats about their eligiblity pls furnish information.
