Sub: TSMC – Registration of Medical Practitioners working in Govt and Private Hospitals and Colleges in the Telangana State Medical Council as per IMC Regulations, 2002 – Certain instructions issued.

Ref: 1) APMP Registration Act, 1968 adapted to State of Telangana.  
2) Indian Medical Council (Professional conduct, Etiquette and Ethics) Regulations, 2002.  
3) Medical Education HM&FW, Rules, 2013 in GOMs No 129, HM&FW (E2) Dept, dt 08.08.2013.

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As per the Amended Act No 10 of 2013 to APMP Regn Act, 1968 and the Rules made there under all the Medical Practitioners with PG Qualifications, Degree, Diploma, Super Speciality have to render compulsory Govt Service as a Senior Resident for a period of one year in the Telangana State as per the posting orders issued by the Director of Medical Education, Telangana, Hyderabad. This mandatory resident service also applies to Medical Practitioners who obtain degrees from other states who are willing to work in Telangana. A registered Medical Practitioner who posses PG Qualification without one year resident service is not eligible to do private practice in a Clinic or Hospital or a College and who are not registered with Telangana State Medical Council.

If any Medical Practitioner with additional qualification passed after 02.08.2013 without rendering one year compulsory Govt Service as Senior Resident and not registered the additional qualification is not eligible to practice in a Govt or Private setup and shall be liable for disciplinary action.

Now it is reliably learnt that some of the Medical Practitioners are practicing with registration of MCI in Corporate/Private Hospitals without registration with Telangana State

Medical Council (avoiding one year compulsory resident service). Such Medical Practitioners are liable for disciplinary action as per Act No 10/2013.

The names of such Hospitals where Medical Practitioners with registration of MCI but not registered with Telangana State Medical Council to avoid one year Compulsory Resident Service shall be reported to the District Medical and Health Officer concerned who is the "Registering Authority" of Private Hospitals, Clinics, Diagnostic Centres for cancellation of their registration as per the powers vested with them under the "AP Private Medical Care Establishments (Registrations and Regulations) Act, 2002, for contravening the regulations.

In view of the above Acts and Rules all the Superintendents and Principals of Govt and Private Hospitals and Colleges and Managements of Private Hospitals in the Telangana State are once again advised to follow the above provisions failing which appropriate disciplinary action will be taken against them and shall be reported to the Government.

These instructions must be followed scrupulously.
