

7. Subject Matter: Related to Rules & Regulations of CCIM for Appointments, etc.
8. Details of Information requested- **Attested Copies of information in details, as under:-**
 - (i) According to CCIM – a Lecturer can be promoted as Reader in the subject only after having five years teaching experience in the same subject i.e. the subject in which one is basically appointed. Kindly provide rules under which the CCIM is accepting promotion of a person from Lecturer to Reader in another subject.
 - (ii) Please provide CCIM rules regarding appointments, promotions, teaching experience which are differently applicable for Govt./Private/Minority Ayurveda Colleges.
 - (iii) According to CCIM- “Allied subject is applicable at the time of basic appointment only”. Kindly provide rules regarding promotion from Lecturer to Reader or from Reader to Professor in allied subject *without having any teaching experience of that subject*.
 - (iv) According to CCIM for promotion from Lecturer to Reader- five years teaching experience & from Reader to Professor ten years teaching experience is mandatory. Kindly provide rules under which a Lecturer can be promoted as Reader with teaching experience about three years (which is less than five years as per existing rules) and then as Professor with total teaching experience of eight years.
 - (v) As per CCIM’s letter- misc.No.-11-70/2006-unani-7649 dated 19/10/2006 & Order F-no.-28-13/2008-ayu(1) dated 08/10/2008 “CCIM does not accept Contractual appointees as teachers in Ayurveda Colleges”. Please provide rules/letters/Oms circulated to Madhya Pradesh Directorate of ISM&H/AYUSH during the period 2006 to 2017 giving relaxation to Govt. Colleges for approving contract appointments for affiliation.
 - (vi) Circulars/OMs of Ministry of HRD, Govt. of India, issued for degree/PG college teachers, (copy of which is sent to the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare) are applicable to teaching staff of Ayurveda Colleges also imparting Higher Medical Education leading to award of degree. Kindly provide CCIM’s action to provide UGC pay-scale etc. to these college teachers.
9. Period to which the information relates: Since colleges/UGC guidelines came into existence.
