

1. What is the procedure to fill the All India Quota (AIQ) seats which would be reverted to respective states on 16th August, 2017? Please explain the procedure which would be followed in filling these seats.
2. Would a candidate need state's domicile to become eligible to apply for these seats reverted to that state or any NEET qualified candidate across India can apply for these seats? For ex, For a AIQ (15% quota ) seat reverted to Rajasthan state, can a candidate from a state other than Rajasthan apply for it?
3. Would this candidate require Rajasthan's domicile to apply to these seats?
4. Since all the states have closed the registration for their state counseling by now. How can I register and apply to these reverted seats under the mop-up round? For. ex: The state of Uttar Pradesh has reopened their registration, would registering for it make a candidate having Rajasthan Domicile, eligible for applying to the reverted seats in the govt MBBS institutes in UP.
5. Would other states reopen registration for their mop-up round to fill these reverted seats to candidates across India? Has it been made mandatory by the central authority to do so?

Please reply the above queries within 2 days otherwise we have to go to the supreme court since the counselling for MBBS seats is getting over pretty soon.
