



1. That the appellant had sent Janhit Yachika before the Hon'ble Chief Justice, Delhi High Court at New Delhi on dated 06.04.2017, sent through Speed Post to all the relevant likely Shri Narinder Modi Prime Minister/ Shri Raj Nath Singh Home Minister Government of India, Hon'ble Lt. Governor of Delhi, Commissioner of Police, Joint C.P. Eastern Range, Delhi Police posted through Speed Post on dated 07.04.2017.
2. That the public information officer DCP office North East District, Delhi Police letter no.3648 dated 13.07.2017 and letter no.3431 dated 30.06.2017 PIO Shri Giriraj Singh, replied by information letters if the appellant is not satisfied, put up the appeal before the first appellate authority RTI Act 2005 for your kind consideration regarding Shanti Sewa Nayay against the respondents who involve the appellant son namely Deepak Gupta in a false and fabricated case as sale/purchase theft mobile phone respondent no.1 to 5

were totally responsible for the same on dated 28.02.2016.

3. That the with the help of police informers demanded Rs.50,000/- from the appellant to release Deeapak Gupta. The appellant paid Rs.50,000/- to released his son Deepak Gupta, also put up complaint cases before the Hon'ble Courts, Court No.66, Court No.72 against the respondents the case are pending also in hearing.
