Dear Sir,

Applicant's complaint recorded under DD No. 22B Dated 11-June-2017 at the Police Station Ashok Vihar is in regards with the suspicion of economic offence committed by the Post Office and applicant believes that this matter is not Civil in Nature. Applicant has already provided evidence of his investment in the post office Monthly Income Scheme and details of credit of interest into the applicant's savings account; however, it is also clear from the statement enclosed with applicant's complaint that the maturity amount has not been credited into the applicant's savings account. On follow up with the Post Office, applicant has been informed that the maturity amount has already been paid, however, in reply to the applicant's RTI application, Post Office refused to provide any details. It is important to note that applicant has not submitted any claim for the maturity amount to the post office, hence, under such circumstances; post office could not have paid the maturity amount. Applicant fears that the Post Office having knowledge about the civil dispute between the

applicant and his wife, has taken advantage in misappropriating the funds, otherwise the fund should still be available with the Post Office.


