Appeal against the RTI Reply vide Number - ID No. 2364/17/6054/RTI-Cell/NWD dated 23/08/2017

Dear Sir,

As the Ld PIO failed to send the true, complete information but sent the vague/misleading reply, so the appellant herewith is filing his appeal with a requested to Hon'ble 1st Appellate Authority to issue directions to send true, complete and upto date information:-

1. That in the past, similar information of other period has been supplied many times by the same office. Then it is a matter of surprise that on what ground now, the similar information of different period has been denied which is totally unfair and unjustified.
2. That the demanded information is in large public interest as mass level of laws have been violated and lives of innocents are at high risk.
3. That the demanded information are of government records of i.e. Delhi Police which cannot be denied by the Ld PIO who is bound to supply the information.
4. That the demanded information relates to massive level of corruption and concealing the information to suppress the facts, indicates that instead of curbing the corruption, efforts are being made to carpet the corruption which is totally unfair in the eyes of law.
5. That Section 8(1)(j) does not give any Blanket cover and does not even apply here. Ld PIO has unfairly denied the information. In fact Ld PIO should be of broader thinking and believe in providing maximum information which helps to curb the corruption.
6. That even if any information is not available with the said PIO, he was duty bound to transfer the RTI Application to the concerned PIO u/s 6(3) of RTI Act, but the PIO failed to do so.

- (ii) As the PIO failed to send the information within the prescribed time limit of 30 days, so kindly direct to send the information free of cost as per Section 7(6) of RTI Act.
- (iii) Any other orders/relief in favour of the appellant, may also be passed in the interest of the justice.
