

4. I would like to inspect and receive copies of references/requests made by Delhi Police to the concerned authorities/companies for putting these mobile phone on "tracking"
5. How many mobile phones were reported to have been lost/pickpocketed and registered with the Delhi Police since July 2016 to date ?
6. How many mobiles had been put on "tracking" and how many of them have been successfully "tracked" and recovered since July, 2016 ?
7. How many mobile phones have been recovered by Delhi Police, in all, through "tracking" or otherwise and restored to their owners ?
8. What additional steps, if any, Delhi Police proposes to take to ensure early recovery of lost/pickpocketed mobile phones.
9. I would like to inspect all the relevant records, relating to the requests/questions mentioned above and get the copies of such papers that I identify in the course of my inspection.
10. The RTI application fee of Rs. 10/- is enclosed in the IPO form.
