During the hearing the respondent CPIO Ms. Jyoti Bhaskar, Sr. EDPM, Lucknow Division submitted that a full and comprehensive reply was provided to the appellant on 22.11.2016. Since the same was not available in the case record, the respondent PIO was asked to read the same over the VC facility. She was intimated to send a copy of the same to the Commission through e-mail for record.

The appellant submitted during the hearing that he had not received any reply so far, to the points raised by him in his above stated RTI application.

On perusal of the case record, it was seen that the respondent CPIO's reply of 09.12.2015 was neither just nor proper and not even comprehensive in character. However, the revised reply sent on 22.11.2016 was comprehensive.

The respondent CPIO is directed to resend a copy of the reply dated 22.11.2016 along with documents, if any, to the appellant within 15 days of the receipt of the order.

The respondent CPIO is further directed to send a compliance report containing the copy of the reply and the despatch details within 07 days thereafter to the Commission for record.
