**ORDER**

1. Shri Manohar Lal filed an application dated 05.03.2014 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), National Human Rights Commission (NHRC) seeking information on nine points, including, (1) name and designation of the concerned authority which was responsible for taking action on complaints sent by him via e-mail, (2) certified copy of all the documents regarding action taken by the concerned

authority on his complaints and (3) what is the time limit to solve the grievance – provide certified copy of provision/rule relating to it.

**2.** Shri Manohar Lal filed a complaint dated 18.03.2014 before the Commission on the grounds that he has not received any reply from the N.H.R.C. and requested the Commission to take action against the concerned officers of N.H.R.C. for not providing the information within the specified time as specified under the RTI Act and impose penalty on them.

**Hearing:**

**3.** The complainant Manohar Lal was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Indrajeet Kumar, Assistant Registrar(Law) & CPIO was present in person.

**4.** The respondent submitted that point-wise information was provided to the complainant on 28.03.2014. The respondent further submitted that no complaint was filed by the complainant.

**Decision:**

**5.** The Commission, after hearing of the submissions of the respondent and perusing the records, observes that information in response to the RTI application was provided to the complainant. Hence, no further intervention is required in the matter.

**6.** With the above observations, the complaint is disposed of.
