ORDER

Facts:

1. RTI application is not on record. As per First Appellate authority response, complainant is seeking information regarding details of the official documents relating to his termination.
2. The CPIO responded on 06.03.2013 and 15.04.2013. First Appeal is not on record, As per First Appellate authority response, the Complainant filed first appeal dated 03.05.2016. The FAA responded on 11.06.2013. The complainant filed Complaint on 05.11.2013 before the Commission to take action against the respondent for not providing the information to the complainant.

Hearing:

3. Complainant is absent. Respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing.
4. Respondent stated that complainant had filed RTI Application on 04.02.2013, vide their letter dated 06.03.2013 and 15.04.2013.

They have informed the complainant that information sought is too old. Respondent further stated that complainant has sought information regarding his personal files, which is 35 years old and is not available in their office. Despite this, complainant has been repeatedly seeking information on the same issue by filing fresh RTI applications.

Discussion/ observation:

5. The Commission observed that action taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. Commission further advise the complainant that he should not waste precious time of the Commission and the respondent by approaching to seek information on the same issue through filing multiple RTI's applications.

Decision:

6. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter. The complaint is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
