ORDER

1. Shri D.K. Bose filed an application dated 05.02.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), South East District, Delhi Police seeking copies of documents pertaining to his complaint dated 11.10.2014 and a copy of the status report.

2. The appellant filed a second appeal dated 02.07.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that the CPIO did not furnish the requisite information and the First Appellate Authority (FAA) upheld the reply of the CPIO. The appellant further requested that penalty be imposed under Section 20(1) of the RTI Act against the CPIO.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri D.K. Bose and the respondent Shri B.S. Khatana, ACP, South-East District, Delhi Police were present in person.

4. The appellant submitted that complete information as sought by him in his RTI application has not been provided to him by the respondent. The appellant further submitted that documents relating to his complaint as sought in point no. 1 of the RTI application has not been provided to him.

5. The respondent submitted that on the complaint of the appellant dated 11.10.2014, a preliminary enquiry was conducted and as per the report of ACP, Ambedkar Nagar, no cognizable offence was made out and, therefore, the complaint was filed and no FIR was lodged. The respondent further submitted that the appellant was informed about the same vide letter dated 11.03.2015.

Decision:

6. The Commission, after hearing both the parties and perusing the records, observes that the appellant was informed about the status of his complaint. However, the related documents as sought in point no. 1 of the RTI application were not provided to the appellant by the respondent. In view of this, the Commission directs the respondent to provide a copy of the report of the Investigating Officer in the said matter to the appellant, within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this decision.

7. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
8. Copy of the decision be provided free of cost to the parties.
