**ORDER**

1. Shri Vikas Malik filed a complaint dated 05.01.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) with the Central Information Commission (CIC) stating that the respondent i.e., Delhi Police, East District did not comply with the Order No. CIC/SS/A/2013/001236/VS/06914 dated 26.05.2014 whereby the respondent had been directed to take action as assured in para 8 and provide the information. The respondent was also directed to enable the appellant to inspect the relevant documents along with providing photo copies of the pertinent documents within 30 days of the Order. The respondent had stated that (Para 8) they should be give one more opportunity to examine the file and they will send a detailed reply both to the appellant and the Commission within the next 2-3 weeks.

**Hearing:**

2. The complainant Shri Vikas Malik was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Kishan, Asst. Sub-Inspector, Delhi Police was present in person.

3. The respondent submitted that the order of the Commission dated 26.05.2014 in File No. CIC/SS/A/2013/001236/VS/06914 has been complied with and accordingly information was provided to the complainant vide letter dated 24.11.2014. The respondent further submitted that the complainant was also advised to inspect the relevant files.

**Decision:**

4. The Commission, after hearing the respondent and perusing the records, observes that the order of the Commission dated 26.05.2014 has been complied with by the respondent. However, as per the complaint of the complainant, it appears that the information has not been received by him. In view of this, the Commission directs the respondent to resend the letter dated 24.11.2014 to the complainant within a period of two weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this decision.

5. With the above observations, the complaint is disposed of.

6. Copy of decision be given free of cost to the parties.
