The appellant had sought copy of the complaint filed against him.

Grounds for Second Appeal

The CPIO did not provide the desired information.

Order

Appellant : **Present**
Respondent : **PIO, Shri Abhishek Paswan, Sr. DPO**

During the hearing the respondent CPIO submitted that they had provided the requisite information vide their letter dated 16.11.2015 in connection with the RTI application dated 05.10.2015. The appellant submitted that he received an incomplete reply from the respondent.

On perusal of the case record, it was seen that the annexure with the reply to point no. 1 of the said RTI application was not received by the appellant. It should now be provided to the appellant by the respondent CPIO. On the other point of the RTI application, a joint inspection should be organised by the CPIO as recommended by the FAA in his order dated 17.12.2015.

The respondent CPIO is directed to provide a copy of the annexure with the point no. 1 of the said RTI application to the appellant free of charge u/s 7(6) of the RTI Act within 07 days of the receipt of the order.

The respondent CPIO is also directed to organise a joint inspection under his personal supervision on a mutually convenient date and at mutually convenient time and place. Based on the joint inspection, copies of records as selected by the appellant are to be provided then and there to him, free of charge u/s 7(6) of the RTI Act. The entire action is to be completed within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the order.

After the Joint Inspection is over, a report on the Joint Inspection signed by the respondent CPIO, duly countersigned by the appellant with his remark(s), if any, is to be submitted within 7 days thereafter to the commission for perusal and record.

With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.

Copies of the order may be sent to both the parties free of charge.
