ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 24.09.2014 seeking information regarding recruitment for the post of constable in railway police including marks obtained by roll number 4114229200 in Delhi Centre, cut off marks of RRB,NE Rly Gorakhpur, reasons as to why he has not been selected etc.
2. The CPIO response is not on record. The appellant filed first appeal on 07.11.2014 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed appeal on 11.12.2014 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing. The appellant did not participate in the hearing.
4. The responded stated that the appellant has submitted incorrect postal order. Therefore, they have returned appellant's RTI application. The respondent further stated that the appellant has submitted another RTI application dated 27.9.2014. The respondent said that appellant has again

submitted incorrect postal order, but they have replied to the appellant on 26.12.2014 on all the points of his RTI application..

Discussion/Observations:

5. Information has been provided to the appellant. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with RTI application are satisfactory.

Decision:

6. The Commission's intervention is not required in the matter.
