ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 07.12.2015 seeking information regarding daily progress made on his complaint from May 2014 till the date of reply; reasons for delay in taking action on his complaint; name and designation of the officials who have considered his complaint etc..
2. The response of CPIO is not on record. The complainant filed complaint on 22.02.2016 before the Commission to take necessary action on the respondent.

Hearing:

3. The respondent was represented through counsel who was personally present in the hearing. The complainant was absent.

Discussion/Observation:

4. It is observed that similar matters were heard by the Commission on 27.02.2017 in Complaint No. CIC/KY/C/2016/000146 titled as Mr. Sanjay Fondu Bhandare Vs. CPIO, Ministry of External Affairs, Appeal No. CIC/PASOF/A/2016/296649 and on 8.3.2017 in Complaint No. CIC/KY/C/2016/000061 titled as Mr. Sanjay Fondu Bhandare Vs. CPIO, Ministry of External Affairs.

5. It is further noted that the information sought by the complainant in the present case inter-alia covers all queries as sought by him in his earlier cases. An order has already been issued to give complete copy of his file to the complainant.

Decision:

6. The respondent is directed to ensure that information should be supplied within 15 days of this order.

7. The respondent is directed to show cause, within 30 days of this order, why action should not be taken against him for contravening the timelines prescribed in the RTI Act.

The complaint is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
