ORDER

1. Shri Farooq filed an application dated 11.02.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Delhi Traffic Police, Headquarters, New Delhi seeking information on fourteen points pertaining to illegal use of EECO and Maruti Vans for transporting the passengers.

2. The appellant filed a second appeal dated 01.07.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that he is not satisfied with the information provided to him by the CPIO and the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The appellant further requested that action should be initiated against the CPIO and the FAA.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Farooq was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri. S.S. Yadav, Inspector, Delhi Traffic Police was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that the RTI application of the appellant dated 11.02.2015 was received in the Delhi Traffic Police Head Quarters on 12.02.2015 and accordingly a reply was sent to the appellant vide letter dated 12.03.2015. The respondent further submitted that the RTI application was also transferred under Section 6(3) of the RTI Act to the CPIO, Delhi Traffic Police, Northern Range and to the CPIO, Transport Department, Government of NCT of Delhi vide letter dated 13.02.2015. The respondent also stated that CPIO, Northern Range has provided point wise information to the appellant vide letter dated 17.03.2015. The respondent further stated that in compliance of the FAA's order dated 07.05.2015, information on point nos. 12 and 14 of the RTI application was provided to the appellant vide letter dated 01.06.2015. Hence, no further information remains to be provided to the appellant.

Decision:

5. The Commission, after hearing the respondent and perusing the records, observes that due information has been provided to the appellant by the respondent. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

6. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
