ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 05.01.2015 seeking information on action taken on his letters dated 30.03.2012 and 04.04.2012 regarding possession of allotted flat.
2. The CPIO responded on 23.01.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 16.02.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 24.02.2015. The appellant filed appeal on 05.05.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that he has not been provided record of action taken, decision and notings on his representations dated 30.03.2012 and 04.04.2012. The appellant stated that reparation/defects have not been rectified/corrected by the respondent even after they were pointed out to IRWO. The appellant stated that he had handed over the Key of the allotted flat to the then project manager and key of the flat has not been handed back to him till date.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letter dated 23.01.2015. The respondent stated that all defects have been repaired. The respondent stated that appellant had signed possession letter thereafter. The respondent stated that the appellant may inspect his file and may take copy of any paper from the file. The respondent stated that the appellant has been informed that there is no file notings/decision in connection with his representations.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. However, complete notings of appellant's flat allotment file may be provided to the appellant, so that he is satisfied about the reply already given in the matter by respondent.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to provide copy of notings part of the file related to appellant's flat allotment within 30 days of this order. Further, the appellant may be allowed to inspect the file and take copy of pertinent documents, free of cost, within 30 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
