ORDER

1. Shri Rajeev Mohan filed an application dated 02.03.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Delhi Police Headquarters seeking information on twenty three points regarding citation for Out of Turn Promotion (OTP) in respect of ASI Ravinder Singh, No. 1028/Crime and H.C. Rajeev Mohan, No.

300/Crime and some other information relating to Out of Turn Promotions (OTP).

2. The appellant filed a second appeal before the Commission on 16.07.2015 on the grounds that he is not satisfied with the reply of the PIO as well as the First Appellate Authority (FAA) as the information provided by them is incomplete, vague and incorrect and thus the queries and grievances of the applicant are unresolved. The appellant requested the Commission to direct the PIO to provide complete information sought by him without any further delay.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Rajeev Mohan and the respondents Shri H.M. Bakshi, ACP (Crime), Delhi Police and Shri Pravin Tuli, ACP, Delhi Police Head Quarters were present in person.

4. The respondent (PHQ) submitted that information on points 1-7, 12-16 of the appellant's RTI application was provided to him vide letter dated 27.03.2015. The respondent also submitted that the appellant was informed that the information sought in point nos. 8-11, 17 and 18-20 does not come under the RTI Act, 2005. The respondent also stated that the RTI application in respect of point nos. 21-23 was transferred to PIO, DCP, Crime, Delhi Police. The ACP and CPIO O/o DCP, Crime submitted that information on points pertaining to them was furnished vide letter dated 27.04.2015.

5. The appellant requested the Commission to grant him some more time to make his submissions in the matter.

Interim Decision:

6. The Commission, considered the request of the appellant and adjourns the matter to **22.11.2016 at 1.15 p.m.**
