ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 23.03.2016 seeking information regarding status of Writ Petition (Civil) Diary No. 40958/2015, Ramchandra Tiwari Vs. Union of India & Others and reasons for not listing before the Court etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 06.04.2016. The appellant filed first appeal on 11.04.2016 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 02.05.2016. The appellant filed appeal on 30.05.2016 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The respondent participated in the hearing. The appellant did not participate in the hearing.
4. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letter dated 04.04.2016. The respondent stated that appellant was informed that the sought for information is in the form of general grievance which is beyond the scope of Section 2 (f) of the RTI Act and cannot be redressed under the

RTI Act. The respondent stated that in respect of point no. 2 the appellant was informed that the mentioned Writ Petition is defective and the defects have already been communicated to him vide letter dated 19.03.2016.

5. The respondent stated that the first appellate authority vide its order dated 02.05.2016 had disposed of the first appeal having concurred with the findings of the CPIO.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

7. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
