**ORDER**

**Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 18.09.2015, seeking information on 8 points regarding leave record, disciplinary action taken for absence without notice, payment of GPF and Insurance Policy of one Shri Rajvir Singh an employee of BSNL etc
2. The CPIO responded on 12.10.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 09.11.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal on 11.01.2016 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant and the respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing.
4. The appellant stated that he has not been provided leave record of Shri Rajvir Singh from 03.05.2010 to 30.06.2010. The appellant stated that the furnished information was not signed by the respondent. The appellant stated that Shri Rajvir Singh was

allegedly involved in a corruption case involving Rs. 1.75 Crore and he is still in the jail. The appellant alleged that the Shri Rajvir Singh was paid salary without attending office.

5. The respondent stated that the sought for information has been provided to the appellant. The respondent stated the sought for information pertains to third party, however, the appellant may visit their office and inspect the files related to the Shri Rajvir Singh and take copies of the identified documents, without cost.

**Discussion/ observation:**

6. The leave record is not personal information. The leave record of Shri Rajvir Singh from 03.05.2010 to 30.06.2010 can be provided to the appellant free of cost. Further, the appellant may be allowed to inspect the record, within 15 days of this order, and the respondent shall provide copy of the documents to be identified by the appellant in the context of his RTI application.

**Decision:**

7. Respondent is directed to take action as per para 6 above within 15 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
