**ORDER**

1. Shri Ishwar Chander filed an application dated 31.03.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF) seeking information on eleven points pertaining to recruitment of Paramedical Staff.

2. The appellant filed a second appeal dated 08.07.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that he is not satisfied with the information provided to him by the CPIO as well as First Appellate Authority (FAA).

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant Shri Ishwar Chander was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri M.K. Verma, Second- in-Command (2I/C), CRPF was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that the CRPF is exempted under Section 24(1) of the RTI Act, except in cases of corruption or human rights violations, both of which are not involved in the present matter. Nonetheless, information as available on record has been provided to the appellant vide the FAA's order dated 15.06.2015.

**Decision:**

5. The Commission, after hearing the submissions of the respondent and perusing the records, observes that the CRPF is exempted under Section 24(1) of the RTI Act, except in cases of corruption or human rights violations, both of which are not involved in the present matter. Nonetheless, information as available on record has already been provided to the appellant by the respondent. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

6. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
