**ORDER**

**Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 17.07.2015, seeking copy service book , education certificates etc. of Shri K. Sahadev Das.
2. The CPIO responded on 20.08.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 22.12.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal on 07.01.2016 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant and the respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing.
4. The appellant stated that he has not been provided complete information. The appellant stated that he want to know as to how Mr. K Saha Dev Das was regularised in service by BSNL, only by producing the school leaving certificate and without the employment exchange registration and police verification and other documents. The appellant stated that the relevant documents

relating to regularisation of the job of the Mr. K Saha Dev Das has not been given to him.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letter dated 20.08.2015. The respondent stated that the service record of the employee is personal information which cannot be given to the appellant under section 8(1)(j) of the RTI Act. The respondent stated that the Mr. K Saha Dev Das was regularised as per extant rules of the department. The respondent stated that before the year, 1995 after 10 year of working with department, the age and education was not a bar for regularisation of a Majdoor. The respondent stated that no enquiry was conducted at the time of regularisation of Mr. K Saha Dev Das. However, in all such cases police verification was done. The respondent stated that copy of the school leaving certificate and regularisation letter of Mr. K Saha Dev Das have been provided to the appellant.

**Discussion/ observation:**

6. The Commission observed that action taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

**Decision:**

7. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter. The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
