FACTS:

- I. Vide RTI application dated **28.05.2014**, the Appellant sought information on **7 issues**.
- II. CPIO, vide its response dated **15.07.2014**, has provided the part information to the Appellant.
- III. The First Appeal (FA) is not on record.
- IV. First Appellate Authority (FAA), is not on record.
- V. Grounds for the Complaint filed on **18.09.2014**, are contained in the Memorandum of Complaint.

HEARING

Appellant as well as respondent appeared before the Commission personally and made the submissions at length.

DECISION

During hearing of the case, it is submitted by Shri Vinay Kumar, Asst. Manager & APIO, that the respondents are now willing to provide the required information to the Appellant. For this, he has also submitted his written submissions dated **16.09.2016** for the kind perusal of this Commission. For the purpose of clarity, it would be appropriate to quote the relevant portion of the respondent's undertaking dated **16.09.2016**, which reads as under:

“Please refer to RTI dated 28.05.2014, the certified copies of all the documents pertaining to point 1 to 7 shall be provided to Shri Inder Pal Singh, RTI Applicant within 10 days.”

2. Furthermore, the Appellant vide his hand written submissions dated **16.09.2016**, requested this Commission to dispose of the instant petition in terms of respondent's undertaking dated 16.09.2016. In view of this, the Commission feels that it would be appropriate and even justified to convert the captioned complaint into a second appeal. Therefore, it is converted into a **second appeal**. Thus, being deal accordingly.
3. The Commissioner heard the submissions made by appellant as well as respondents at length. The Commission also **perused** the case-file **thoroughly**; specifically, **nature of issues** raised by the Appellant in his RTI application dated **28.05.2014**, respondent's response dated **15.07.2014**, other material made available on record including respondent's undertaking dated **16.09.2016**, Appellant's written submissions dated **16.09.2016** and also the grounds of memorandum of Complaint.
4. In view of the **position** above and the **circumstances** of the case, the Commission of is the considered view that it would be **appropriate even justified** to direct Shri Vinay Kumar, Asst. Manager & APIO, to provide the **complete & categorical** information, **issue-wise**, to the appellant as per his RTI application, **in accordance with the provisions of RTI Act 2005**, as per his **hand written undertaking dated 16.09.2016**, within 30 days from the date of receipt of this order under intimation to this Commission. **If need be, Section 5(4) of the RTI Act 2005 may also be invoked in the matter.**

With the above observations, the instant complaint is disposed of.
