ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 25.06.2015 seeking information on 6 points regarding his complaint dated 28.05.2015 viz. (i) Date of receipt of complaint, no. of days it was pending with each concerned officer/clerk and reasons for not taking any action, (ii) Date when grievances would be resolved, (iii) Officer/clerk responsible for not depositing the TDS etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 03.07.2015. The complainant filed first appeal dated 27.07.2015 before the first appellate authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The complainant filed complaint on 30.09.2015 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The complainant did not participate in the hearing. The respondent participated in the hearing through video conferencing.

4. The respondent stated that they have given a reply to the complainant with regard to the sought for information on 03.08.2015.

5. The respondent further stated that earlier due to wrong PAN entry by the outsourcing agency, Form 16 was not generated. He stated that Form 16 has been sent to the complainant on 21.03.2017.

6. The respondent also stated that the mistake by them in depositing TDS of the complainant has since been corrected by rectifying the PAN entry. The TDS of Rs. 324 (FY 2013-14) and Rs. 74 (FY 2014-15) have been deposited.

Discussion/ observation:

7. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

8. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

9. The respondent is advised to ensure correctness of data entry and timely supply of Form 16 for income tax return filing process.

The complaint is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
