ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 13.08.2015 seeking information regarding daily progress report on complaint letter dated 13.02.2015 and reasons for delay in taking action on his complaint; names and designations of the officials who have considered his complaint and the number of days it was lying with each official during this period; details of investigation carried out so far, etc.

2. The CPIO responded on 16.09.2015. The complainant filed first appeal dated nil with the first appellate authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 17.11.2015. The complainant filed a complaint on 11.05.2016 before the Commission to take necessary action on the respondent.

Hearing:

3. The respondent was represented through counsel who was personally present in the hearing. The complainant was absent.

Discussion/ observation:

4. It is observed that similar matters were heard by the Commission on 27.02.2017 in Complaint No. CIC/KY/C/2016/000146 titled as Mr. Sanjay Fondu Bhandare Vs. CPIO, Ministry of External Affairs, Appeal No. CIC/PASOF/A/2016/296649 dated 27.02.2017 titled as Mr. Sanjay Fondu Bhandare Vs. CPIO, Ministry of External Affairs and on 8.3.2017 in Complaint No. CIC/KY/C/2016/000061 titled as Mr. Sanjay Fondu Bhandare Vs. CPIO, Ministry of External Affairs.

5. It is further noted that the information sought by the complainant in the present case inter-alia covers all queries as sought by him in his earlier cases. An order has already been issued to give complete copy of his file to the complainant.

6. Since a reply to RTI had been given, the complaint cannot be sustained.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to ensure that information should be supplied within 15 days of this order.

The complaint is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
