ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 11.07.2015 seeking information regarding action taken on his four letters as mentioned in the RTI application with regard to provision of chairs, desert cooler, training of SBCO staff, MACP etc.

2. The CPIO responded on 07.08.2015. The appellant filed first appeal dated 03.09.2015 with First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 15.10.2015. The appellant filed second appeal on 14.01.2016 before the Commission on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent participated in the hearing personally.

4. The appellant stated that he wants to know the budgetary provisions for North Postal Division, Delhi and Ashok Vihar HO, Delhi for the years 2013-14 & 2014-15. Further appellant stated that he had sent four letters regarding provision of chairs, desert coolers, training of SBCO staff and MACP but he has not been informed as to what action was taken on his these letters. The appellant stated that basic facilities like water, chair, coolers etc. are not being provided to the staff in the office.

5. The respondent stated that the budget and office expenses related information has been provided to the appellant. The respondent stated that the employee has access to internal mechanism for redressal of his grievances. The respondent stated that other than budget related information, rest of the information are in the nature of queries. The respondent stated that they will inform the appellant on action taken on his four letters and a copy of the file notings in this regard will be provided to the appellant.

Discussion/ observation:

6. Budget related information has been provided to the appellant. However, information as brought out in para 5 needs to be provided.

7. The appellant has raised grievance relating to availability of basic facilities like water, chairs, coolers etc. He stated that while budgetary allocations exist for these, the employees are not getting these basic amenities and funds are being surrendered. Sr. Supdt. Post Offices, North Postal Division is advised to look into this grievances.

Decision:

8. The respondent is directed to provide to the appellant on action taken on his four letters as stated in para 5 above, free of cost, within 15 days of this order,.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
