FACTS:

2. Complainant had sought for information regarding her husband who was admitted in IHBAS, Delhi due to drug addiction from 13.10.2013 to 06.11.2013. She wanted the date on which he was admitted for treatment on or after 01.01.2014 to till date etc. PIO replied on 04.05.2016. Complainant filed First Appeal and thereafter, approached the Commission.

Decision:

3. The appellant narrowed down his demand for information to a simple point: whether Mr. Sanjay Singh was given a certificate regarding his health condition or not. The request for treatment records of the patients in the public authority is stayed by Hon'ble Delhi High Court. But the point of information sought by the appellant appears to be neither personal nor treatment related record. In spite of repeated request, the PIO did not answer on this point. The FAA and Director Dr. Nimesh requested for another date of hearing. The

Commission, therefore, affords one final opportunity to the PIO to make his representation. The Case is posted for 01.12.2016 at 2:30 PM. Disposed of.
