ORDER

1. Shri V.K. Goel filed an application dated 04.07.2013 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), Union Bank of India seeking certain information.

2. Shri V.K. Goel filed a complaint dated 04.02.2014 before the Commission on the grounds that he has not received any response to his appeal dated 06.12.2013 against the Union Bank of India and another appeal dated 10.01.2014 against the Ministry of Finance, filed by him before the Commission. The complainant requested the Commission to get him justice and proper information from the Union Bank of India and the Ministry of

Finance and impose penalty as per rule so that he can receive the required information without any further delay.

Hearing:

3. The complainant Shri V.K. Goel was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Vijay Bhalla, Dy. Registrar to IC(SH) was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that no RTI application has been filed with the CPIO, CIC in the present matter. The respondent further submitted that the complainant had directly filed a complaint with the Commission against Ministry of Finance, wherein, Ministry of Finance has not been impleaded as a party and instead the Commission is impleaded as a party but the same is not involved in the present matter as the matter is between the complainant and Ministry of Finance (Banking Division). The respondent also stated that a second appeal in the matter against the Union Bank of India has been heard and disposed of by the Commission vide Decision Nos. CIC/SH/A/2014/001611, CIC/SH/A/2014/002278 etc. dated 09.09.2015.

Decision:

5. The Commission, after hearing the respondent and perusing the records, observes that a second appeal in a similar matter has already been heard and disposed of by the Commission vide Decision Nos. CIC/SH/A/2014/001611, CIC/SH/A/2014/002278, CIC/SH/A/2014/001817 and CIC/SH/A/2014/003122 dated 09.09.2015. Hence, no further action is required in the matter.

6. With the above observations, the complaint is disposed of.
