Information sought:

The appellant had sought copy of service book/ sheets of Bauribandhu Jani including his promotions/ punishments/ proceedings, total leave particulars, qualifying services, copy of detailed calculations of retirement dues including rough and final calculations and the payments details.

Grounds for Second Appeal

The CPIO did not provide the desired information.

Order

During the hearing the respondent CPIO submitted that they had provided the requisite reply vide their letter dated 22.12.2014 in connection with the RTI application dated 03.12.2014.

On perusal of the case record, it was seen that the reply dated 22.12.14 was a covering letter containing a letter dated 19.12.14 from the DPO, Khurda.

Since the enclosures of the letter dated 19.12.2014 was not available in the case record, the respondent PIO was asked to read the same over the VC facility. He was intimated to send a copy of the same to the Commission through e-mail for record.

After hearing this reply, the Commission came to the conclusion that the reply dated 22.12.14 was just and proper and in time. However, a copy of this reply is not available with the appellant as per his contention during the hearing.

The respondent CPIO is directed to resend the reply complete in all respects to the appellant along with all the annexure sent earlier within 15 days of the receipt of the order.

The respondent CPIO is further directed to send a compliance report containing the copy of the reply and the despatch details of the same to the appellant within 07 days thereafter to the Commission for record.

With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.
