ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 05.09.2014 seeking information on 11 points pertaining to details of Shri Ramesh Gupta with regard to (i) Whether Shri Ramesh Gupta was appointed, if so, name of the designated authority concerned with said appointment, (ii) Certified documents deposited by Shri Ramesh Gupta at the time of appointment, (iii) Why Shri Gupta has been not transferred from Yamuna Nagar since 1992, (iv) Salary details along with pay scale and pay band, etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 07.10.2014 by giving a point wise reply to the complainant. The First appeal and FAO response are not on record. The

complainant filed complaint to the Commission on 26.11.2014 on the ground that information should be provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The complainant and the respondent participated in the hearing.

4. The complainant stated that he has not been provided three information viz (i) Certified documents which have been submitted by the employee Shri Ramesh Gupta at the time of appointment (ii) NOC from the department regarding purchase of the property and (iii) rules regarding tenure of the deputation.

5. The respondent stated that pointwise reply had been given to the complainant vide letter dated 07.10.2014 and further clarification have been given vide letter dated 27.02.2017.

6. The respondent stated that Shri Ramesh Gupta has been appointed on regular post and he can be transferred any time in public interest. He is not on deputation.

7. The respondent referred to this Commission's decision CIC/AD/A/2013/001541SA and stated that the documents request by the appellant at relate 4(i) above to personal information of the third party. The respondent stated that the disclosure of the information would cause unwarranted invasion of the privacy of the individual. The respondent stated that the sought for information is exempted under section 8(1) (j) of the RTI Act. He further stated that the appellant has been informed the Shri Gupta had taken NOC for purchase of property.

Discussion/ observation:

8. One of the sought for documents is personal information of the third party. The information which could be provided, has been provided to the appellant. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application are satisfactory.

Decision:

9. The Commission's intervention is not required in the matter.

The Complaint is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
