ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 24.05.2014 seeking his service record, ACR leave record, personal file from June 2006 to August 2009.

2. The CPIO responded on 05.06.2014, 02.07.2014. The appellant filed first appeal on 18.09.2014 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 15.10.2014. The appellant filed appeal on 06.02.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.

4. The appellant stated that he has not been provided his leave record.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant's APAR from ending 31.03.2008 to 30.03.2010 has been provided to the appellant. The respondent stated that the service record and personal file of the appellant has been handedover to the Ajmer Division as the appellant has joined Ajmer Division. The respondent stated that appellant had worked at 18 units. Out of that, leave record from 12 units has been received. The respondent stated

that for obtaining leave record from remaining units they have to follow up with them and they needed 20 days time. The respondent stated that copy of receipt of service record handover to Ajmer Division has been provided to the appellant.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The sought for information should have been provided to the appellant.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to provide appellant's leave record received from 12 units within 15 days of this order and leave record to be received from remaining units be provided to the appellant within 45 days of this order, free of cost.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
