ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 24.10.2014 seeking information on action taken on his letter dated 14.08.2014 regarding unauthorised passage.

2. The CPIO responded on 11.12.2014. The appellant filed first appeal on 13.01.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 16.01.2015. The appellant filed appeal on 12.02.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.

4. The appellant stated that in the year 2013, dut to heavy rain, the boundary wall had fallen and a school student was crushed to death and later the boundary wall was constructed on the orders of the Railways Authorities but about 25 meter wall still has not been reconstructed and an unauthorised passage was given on the east side of the boundary wall without any proper sanction . The appellant stated that through this unauthorised passage, thefts and pilferage has been taking place.

5. The respondent stated that the action taken on the appellant's letter has been informed to him vide letter dated 07.11.2014. The respondent stated that after the receipt of the complaint, the matter was verified by RPF along with Engineering department. The respondent stated that the engineering department has been requested to block the unauthorised passage. The respondent assured that they will take up the matter with DRM and GM for construction of boundary wall.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. However, updated notings of the file can be provided to the appellant.

Decision:

7. Respondent is directed to provide to the appellant the updated file notings , free of cost, within 21 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
