ORDER

1. Shri Pradeep Dutta filed an application dated 09.06.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), South East District, Delhi Police seeking inspection of roznamcha of PS Greater Kailash, Part 1, New Delhi from 30.01.2002 to 05.02.2002 and attested copy of the roznamcha of 30.01.2002 from 08.00 a.m. to 12.00 a.m.

2. The appellant filed a second appeal dated 23.10.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that the CPIO has denied inspection of the roznamcha under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act. The First Appellate Authority (FAA) vide order dated 25.08.2015 had directed the CPIO to provide the information sought, but he has not received any letter asking him to deposit the amount of copying charges as per the RTI Act.

Hearing:

3. The appellant Shri Pradeep Dutta and the respondent S.I. Sanjeev Kumar, South East District, Delhi Police were present in person.

4. The appellant submitted that the FAA vide order dated 25.08.2015 had directed the CPIO to allow the inspection of the Roznamcha from 30.01.2002 to 05.02.2002 and also provide the copy of Roznamcha dated 30.01.2002 from 08.00 AM to 12 AM only. The appellant submitted that he had inspected the Roznamcha at Police Station Greater Kailash, Part-I and had requested for certified copies of certain pages. However, copies of all the documents required were not provided to him.

5. The respondent submitted that copies of the requisite documents were provided to the appellant vide letter dated 21.10.2015. The respondent further submitted that as regards the copies relating to Roznamcha of 04.02.2015, the appellant was asked to collect the same from Police Station Greater Kailash, Part-I.

Decision:

6. The Commission, after hearing the submissions of both the parties and perusing the records, finds that complete information has not been provided to the appellant. The Commission, therefore, directs the respondent to provide the copy of Roznamcha dated 04.02.2002 as requested vide appellant's letter

dated 21.09.2015 to him within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

7. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
8. Copy of the decision be provided free of cost to the parties.
