**ORDER**

1. Shri Jasprit Singh filed an application dated 29.04.2015 under the Right to Information Act, 2005 (RTI Act) before the Central Public Information Officer (CPIO), South West District, Delhi Police seeking certified copies of Complaint Nos. (i) DD No.24 A dated 04.01.2013, (ii) DD No.35B dated 17.05.2013, (iii) DD No.23A dated 23.06.2013 and (iv) DD No.57B dated 10.02.2014.

2. The appellant filed a second appeal dated 07.10.2015 before the Commission on the grounds that the CPIO had denied the information stating that the same is 'third party information' and when directed by the First Appellate Authority (FAA) to provide comprehensive, point-wise information, denied information on point nos.1, 2 and 4 under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act and as for point no.3, transferred his RTI application to the PIO, Dwarka Court, New Delhi stating that the case is pending trial before the Dwarka Court. The appellant requested the Commission to provide the information sought by him and compensate him for the mental harassment which he is undergoing as he is not able to defend his case properly for lack of the desired information.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant ShriJasprit Singh was not present despite notice. The respondent Shri Anand Prakash, APIO, South West District, Delhi Police was present in person.

4. The respondent submitted that in compliance with the FAA's order dated 07.07.2014, the appellant was informed vide letter dated 27.07.2015 that the enquiries on the complaints mentioned in point nos. 1, 2 and 4 of the RTI application are pending and, therefore, the copies of the complaints cannot be provided as the same may impede the process of enquiry and hence, its disclosure is exempted under Section 8(1)(h) of the RTI Act. The respondent further submitted that copies of the complaints mentioned in point nos.1, 2 and 4 has since been provided to the appellant vide letter dated 24.11.2016. The respondent further submitted that the appellant was also informed as regards that the complaint filed vide DD No.23 A dated 13.06.2013, a case FIR no.406/13 dated 06.11.2013 under Section 506 IPC was registered in PS Dwarka. The respondent also stated that a copy of the complaint filed vide DD No.23 A dated 13.06.2013 along with a copy of the FIR no.406/13 dated 06.11.2013 will be provided to the appellant.

**Decision:**

5. The Commission, after hearing the submissions of the respondent and perusing the records, directs the respondent to provide a copy of the complaint filed vide DD No.23 A dated 13.06.2013 along with a copy of the FIR no.406/13 dated 06.11.2013 to the appellant within a period of four weeks from the date of receipt of a copy of this order.

6. With the above observations, the appeal is disposed of.
