ORDER

Facts:

1. The complainant filed RTI application dated 28.02.2015 seeking information that whether any SLP has been admitted against the Karnataka High Court order dated 04.04.2005 passed in WP No. 41599/1999.
2. The CPIO response is not on record. The Complainant filed complaint on 16.06.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The complainant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The complainant stated that he had sent letter dated 28.02.2015 to the Hon'ble Supreme Court but he has not been informed of action taken on this letter. The appellant stated that he was wrongly punished. The Army Supply Cops (ASC) has not yet complied with the order dated 04.04.2005 of the High Court. The complainant stated that he has not been given pension as per his eligibility. The complainant stated that he retired on 01.09.1998 from the Army Service Core Supply. His number was 637676274 H

5. The respondent stated that subject matter of complainant does not relate to the Supreme Court of India. He had complained against the Head Quarter Wing ASC Central Bangalore Record. The respondent further stated that neither RTI application nor any First Appeal was received. However, the case records of the Hon'ble Supreme Court can be searched on the website viz www.sci.nic.in.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory.

Decision:

7. No action is required in the matter at the level of this Commission.

8. The Secretary, Ministry of Defence is advised to take appropriate action in the complainant's matter expeditiously.

The complaint is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
