**ORDER**

**Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 25.11.2013 seeking information on his eligibility for MACP and leave encashment benefits.
2. The CPIO responded on 20.03.2014. The appellant filed first appeal on 26.01.2014 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 03.03.2014. The appellant filed appeal on 02.03.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that his pension has still not been revised.
5. The respondent stated that the appellant vide letter dated 20.03.2014 has been informed that the matter regarding his eligibility for MACP was reviewed. A letter was sent to HQs for clarification of the circular in question. Leave encashment of 300 days LAP has already been given to the applicant at the time of settlement benefit on superannuation. The appellant further informed that regarding leave encashment application for the period as mentioned in RTI application is not available in the record.

6. The respondent stated that the appellant's pension is to be revised. The respondent stated that they will complete the exercise of pension revision within 20 days. The respondent stated that the appellant may visit the office and inspect the record.

7. The respondent stated that the first appellate authority vide its order dated 03.03.2014 had disposed of the first appeal.

**Discussion/ observation:**

8. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. In fact, it is the grievance of the appellant that is yet to be addressed. Full information as sought , has been provided.

**Decision:**

9. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
