ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 20.10.2014 seeking information regarding action taken on complaint dated 04.10.2013, 11.09.2014 pertaining to misbehaviour with the Doctor etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 16.12.2014. The appellant filed first appeal on 06.01.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 05.02.2015. The appellant filed appeal on 19.03.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant through advocate and respondent participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant referred to his RTI application and stated that the sought for information has not been provided to him.
5. The respondent stated that the appellant has been replied to vide letter dated 16.12.2014. The respondent stated that as per the RTI Act only information available in the form of document/office records are to be provided to information seeker. The respondent stated that the grievances settlement or reply to questions raised is not in the purview of the RTI Act.

The respondent stated that the question asked in the RTI application are only grievance's redressal. In this regard, the respondent has referred decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court passed in the matter of Central Board of Secondary Education & Anr Vs. Aditya Bandopadhyay & Ors.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The action/steps taken by the respondent in dealing with the RTI application is satisfactory. In the instant matter the appellant has asked question not information.

Decision:

7. No further intervention of the Commission is required in the matter.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
