### **Dharamvir Singh v. PIO, Tihar Jail**

#### **Parties Present:**

1. Appellant is not present. Mr. Naveenj Katarya, Superintendent and Ms. Neetu Chugh, Asstt. Superintendent represented Public authority.

#### **FACTS:**

2. Appellant has filed RTI application dated 13.1.2015 seeking information about admission of Rambir Tyagi s/o Satish Kumar in Jail, such as how many officers arrested him; name, designation and address of them; name designation and address of doctors given him treatment during period of incarceration, etc. He was informed on 12.3.2015 that no record about escort party who brought prisoner to jail was maintained by them and information regarding medical treatment was personal information of third party, hence could not be given. He requested again on 30.3.2015 from PIO of Central Jail-1, Tihar, asking to give

information about escort or transfer the same to other concerned. Then the RTI application was transferred to DCP 3<sup>rd</sup> Bn DAP Vikaspuri with request to provide information on first two points. PIO Rajesh Kumar in his letter dated 12.3.2015 stated that records about treatment to another prisoner could not be given as it was personal information of that prisoner. Officiating senior medical officer Central Jail 1, Dispensary, Tihar has furnished to PIO of Central Jail No.1 the copies of MLC from Lok Nayak Hospital and Medical Mulahiza, investigation report done at Central Jail No.1, OPD card, stating that said inmate visited the dispensary once.

On 30<sup>th</sup> March 2015, the appellant wrote to CPIO to provide information of medical treatment directly to accused Rambir Tyagi. That was done.

### **Proceedings Before the Commission:**

3. PIO submitted that in question No. 1 and 2, appellant wants detail of escort party provided to Mr. Rambir Tyagi. Appellant also asked the name of Doctors who treated Mr. Rambir Tyagi. Due to security reasons these information cannot be provided under Section 8(1)(g). Moreover, medical record of another accused falls under the exemption of section 8(1)(j) of RTI Act, but it was already given to concerned person who was treated.

Having heard the submission and perusal of records, it is observed that sufficient information is provided to the appellant. Accordingly, appeal is **closed**.
