Information sought:

The appellant had sought information on 5 points, relating to recruitment on account of abilities in various branches of sports & other related information.

Grounds for Second Appeal

The CPIO did not provide the desired information.

Order

During the hearing the appellant submitted that he received the requisite reply only in regard to the point no. 4. The appellant submitted that he was offered joint inspection in regard to rest of the points by the respondent as the records involved were voluminous in nature, he however refused to go in for joint inspection of records as that was not convenient for him and he wanted information from the respondent CPIO.

On perusal of the case record, it was seen that sought for information is clearly voluminous in nature. The Commission agrees with the view of the CPIO that joint inspection on rest of the points would be proper & time saving.

In view of the above, the respondent CPIO is directed to fix a joint inspection under his personal supervision on a mutually convenient date and at mutually convenient time and place. Based on the joint inspection, copies of records as selected by the appellant are to be provided then and there to the appellant free of charge u/s 7(6) of the RTI Act. The entire action is to be completed within a period of 15 days from the date of receipt of the order.

After the Joint Inspection is over, a report on the Joint Inspection signed by the respondent CPIO and duly countersigned by the appellant with his remark(s), if any is to be submitted within 7 days thereafter to the Commission for record.

With the above direction, the appeal is disposed of.
