**ORDER**

**Facts:**

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 28.02.2011 seeking information on 4 points viz copy of the Token Register of Memu/Shed/Rjy j from dated 10.01.2009 to 15.01.2009, copy of Attendance Register, copy of Shift Diary, copy of leave letter etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 31.03.2011. The appellant filed first appeal on 02.03.2012 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 17.04.2012. The appellant filed appeal on 17.02.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

**Hearing:**

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that a copy of shift diary and copy of leave letter sanctioned from 02.02.2009 to 06.02.2009 & 09.02.2009 to 13.02.2009 has not been provided to him.
5. The respondent stated that appellant's attendance register, day diary, name of the Token Board Supervisor and other relevant record in the context of RTI application that were available with them have been furnished to him.

The respondent stated that in the appeal he is seeking additional/new information. The respondent stated that copy of Token Register, and shift diary from 10.01.2009 to 15.01.2009 and leave letter sanctioned from 02.02.2009 to 06.02.2009 & 09.02.2009 to 13.02.2009 are not available with them.

**Discussion/ observation:**

6. On query from the Commission, the respondent stated that they are not able to confirm that the record which is stated to be not available has been weeded out or is not traceable and what is its record retention period etc. However, the respondent sought 15 days to reply to the query of the Commission.

**Decision:**

7. The matter is adjourned and the matter may be listed for hearing after 15 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
