ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 14.03.2014 seeking information regarding acquisition of plot no. 723 and details of compensation paid etc.
2. The CPIO responded on 18.11.2014. The appellant filed first appeal on 28.11.2014 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA responded on 23.01.2015. The appellant filed appeal on 25.03.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.
4. The appellant stated that he is seeking record of acquisition of plot no. 723 and details of compensation paid. The appellant stated that sought for information has not been provided to him.
5. The respondent stated that the record of acquisition and compensation of the aforesaid land is not available with them. The respondent stated that they have a map/plan of boundary line of the land. The respondent stated

that the acquisition record may be available with the office of the Land Acquisition Collector of the district.

Discussion/ observation:

6. The copy of the map of boundary of land can be provided to the appellant. Further, the RTI application can be transferred to the office of the Land Acquisition Collector of the district under section 6(3) of the RTI Act.

Decision:

7. The respondent is directed to provide certified copy of map of boundary of land to the appellant within 30 days of this order. Further, The respondent is directed to transfer this RTI application to the office of the Land Acquisition Collector of the district on the concerned CPIO in DM office under section 6(3) of the RTI Act within 5 days of this order.

The appeal is disposed of. Copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
