ORDER

Facts:

1. The appellant filed RTI application dated 15.12.2014 seeking information on 14 points with regard to action taken against Mr. Ratan Singh (Railway employee) as per WDAR for leaving the station and scuffle with the appellant on 22.06.2014 for which and FIR No. 143/14 has been lodged with the Kotwali Lalitpur etc.

2. The CPIO responded on 22.01.2015. The appellant filed first appeal on 29.01.2015 with the First Appellate Authority (FAA). The FAA response is not on record. The appellant filed second appeal on 24.03.2015 before the Commission with the plea that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

Hearing:

3. The appellant and the respondent both participated in the hearing.

4. The appellant stated that the sought for information has not been provided to him.

5. The respondent stated that the appellant filed application with the Head Quarter and they have received RTI application on 22.12.2014. The

respondent stated that in their reply of 22.01.2015 the appellant was asked to deposit copying fee Rs. 36 /- for 18 pages but he has not deposited the copying fee amount. The respondent stated that they have the information and they will provide the information to the appellant. The respondent stated that this may not be treated as delayed reply.

6. The appellant stated that the respondent did not provide information within 30 days hence; they should be directed to provide information free of cost.

Discussion/ observation:

7. The respondent agreed to provide the information.

Decision:

8. Respondent is directed to provide information in context with RTI application within 15 days of this order free of cost.

The appeal is disposed of. A copy of the order be given to the parties free of cost.
